

Reminder to all Residence Students:

Students are reminded that they are prohibited from using nails, tacks, hooks, spikes, tape or any other materials to hang pictures, posters and other materials on the walls in their rooms. See the section below concerning assessment costs for using such items.

No part of the premises may be painted, wall-papered, or permanently decorated without the written consent of the Residence Department. Using nails, tacks, hooks, spikes, tape or other items to hang pictures, posters and other material on the walls in your room will result in damage and is not permitted. In instances where the aforementioned items are applied to painted surfaces within a room or apartment, a \$2.00 assessment will result for each item found to be used. Failure to remove these items will result in additional \$2.00 fines. This assessment is over and above any damage to the room caused by the use of the prohibited item.
